## FIFTH GRADE

- If approved, eligible for Bar/t Mitzvah date assignment (depends on birthdate)
- Parent Orientation Meeting with clergy, Bar/t Mitzvah coordinator Sunday morning in spring or fall to receive Bar/t Mitzvah Manual
- 13 Mitzvot Program begins (optional)

## SIXTH GRADE

- ALL students attend Shabbat School for ½ year
- ALL students required to attend at least ¼ of all Religious school sessions
- ALL students required to attend a minimum of 10 Shabbat morning services
- ALL students required to attend classes Sunday mornings for ½ year
- Adult tutor assigned one year prior to Bar/t Mitzvah date
- Family highly encouraged to attend 6<sup>th</sup> grade retreat
- Parent Orientation Meeting with clergy, Bar/t Mitzvah coordinator Sunday morning in spring or fall to receive Bar/t Mitzvah Manual
- Parent/Student classes with clergy (depends on B/BM date)
- Peer tutor available to students in 3-day Hebrew School program; begins 6-9 months prior to Bar/t Mitzvah date
- 13 Mitzvot Program begins or continues (optional)

- ALL students, including those attending PJA, enroll in CNS Religious School
- ALL students attend Shabbat School for ½ year

## SEVENTH GRADE

- ALL students enrolled in Wednesday Night Religious School program
- ALL students required to attend at least ¼ of all Religious school sessions
- ALL students required to attend a minimum of 20 Shabbat morning services
- Adult Tutorial continues or begins
- Parent/Student classes with clergy (depends on B/BM date)
- D'var Torah preparation (1:1 family sessions) with Rabbi on bima approx 2 months before Bar/t Mitzvah
- Peer tutor available to students in Kita Hey; begins or continues 6-9 months prior to Bar/t Mitzvah date (optional)
- 13 Mitzvot Program begins or continues (optional)
